

Ink Techniques 2

Stamp an image using Stampin' Write Markers as your ink!

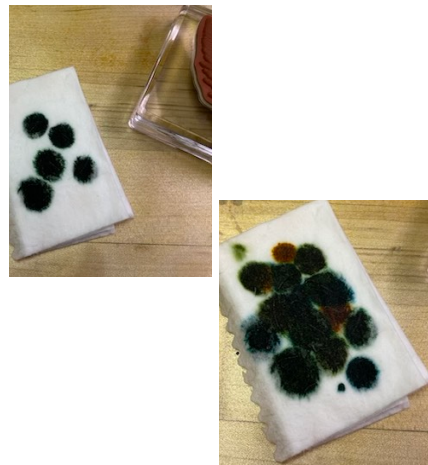
- Start with your lightest color
- Use the side of the brush tip to gently color the stamp
- If coloring has taken a long time then you may find you need to huff warm air onto the stamp before stamping
- Due to covid you may try spritzing with water or lightly stamping a baby wipe (will give different effects)



Baby Wipe Stamp Pad

Create your own stamp pad using a baby wipe and ink refills.

Place a baby wipe on a safe surface and place a few drops of ink from 2 or 3 different ink refills on it. The colors will blend together for a tie dye effect. Use it like a stamp pad.



Water Painters

Use the aqua painter and your Stampin' Up ink to watercolor your images.

You can add one or two drops of ink to an acrylic block and dip your aqua painter directly in it.

If you don't have an ink refill, push your acrylic block into the ink pad and paint away.

Remember to stamp the image with StazOn.
