## 3 Sheet Wonder with Curves

## Materials:

Curvy Christmas Stamp Set
Curvy Dies
Classic Christmas DSP (3-6x6 Sheets cut using curvy die) 6 Shaded Spruce Card Bases
12 Whisper White Card stock pieces cut to $4^{\prime \prime} \times 51 / 4^{\prime \prime}$
3 pieces of scrap Card stock cut to $1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 51 / 4^{\prime \prime}$
(I used Cherry Cobbler, Shaded Spruce, \& Crumb Cake)
Cherry Cobbler, Bumblebee and Shaded Spruce Ink.
Holiday Rhinestones Basic (I used the green ones)
Cutting Diagrams for the 3 sheets of DSP


Cut each DSP sheet at the four inch mark. Then use the curvy die cut with dots on the edge to cut each $4^{\prime \prime} \times 6^{\prime \prime}$ piece into 3 sections and each 2 " $x 4$ " piece into two sections as shown in the pictures below.


I then mixed and matched the pieces to make 6 different cards as shown on page 2. I glued the pieces to Whisper White cut at $4 \prime \times 51 / 4^{\prime \prime}$

## 3 Sheet Wonder with Curves pg 2



Dry Embossed a punched Shaded Spruce Tree with a Wrapped in Texture embossing folder and attached it to the cards with dimensionals.


The different shades of Shaded Spruce was produced by stamping the branch more than once with out reinking the stamp. I used a mask to cover the bow while stamping the branches.


Inside of the cards. The right for the tree card and the left for the branch and bow card.
