

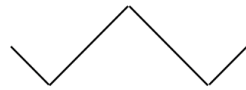
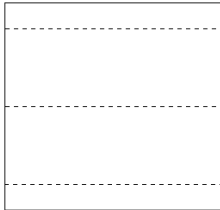
## Easel Card



Card Base 4 1/4" x 11" scored at 5 1/2"

Easel cut in matching cardstock

4" x 4 1/4" scored on the 4" side at:  
1/2", 2", & 3 1/2"



Side View of the Easel Piece

Fold the score lines on the easel piece so that it makes a "W" shape when you look at it from the side. Glue goes on the outside of the 1/2" pieces and attaches to the inside of the card base. As shown in the picture above.

Night of Navy Card Base & Easel

Artistry Bloom DSP 4" x 5 1/4"

Garage Gears Die Cuts

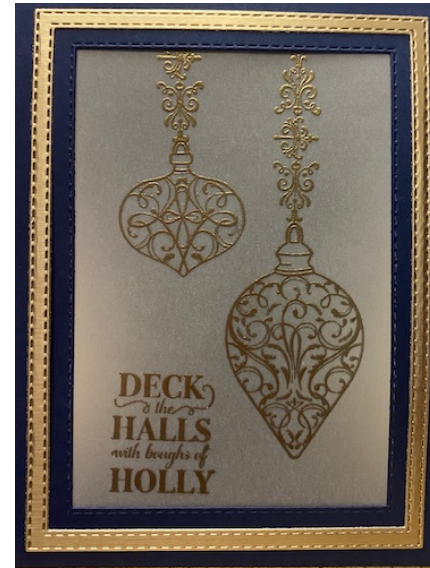
Calendar Mats: Night of Navy 1 13/16" x 2 5/8"

Whisper White 1 7/8" x 2 11/16"

## Easel Card - Luminary



I used the third largest Stitched Rectangle to cut a hole in the front of the card base. I also glued in the Vellum piece before adhering the easel piece.

The Brushed Gold Frame was made by using the largest and second largest stitched frames.

NOTE: I used the small battery operated tea lights since this is a paper luminary.

Night of Navy Card Base

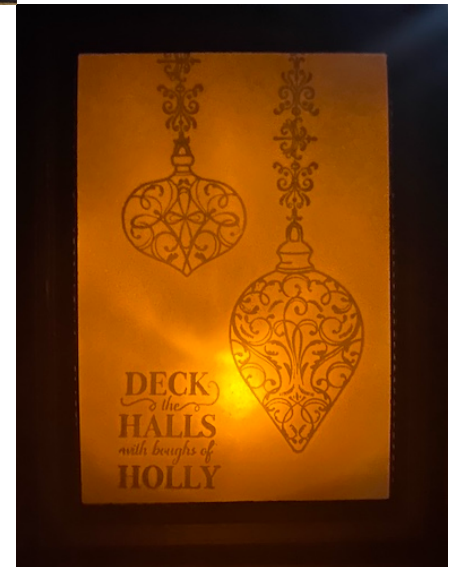
Brushed Metal Cardstock
