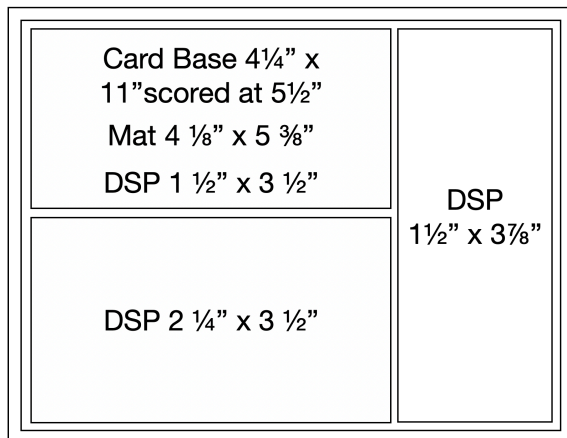


Flip Book 1

The front of card can be decorated however you would like. I used three of the DSP papers that I used on the inside to decorate the front.



Inside Cover Pieces
 (Left Side)
 Mat 4 1/8" x 5 3/8"
 DSP 4" x 5 1/4"

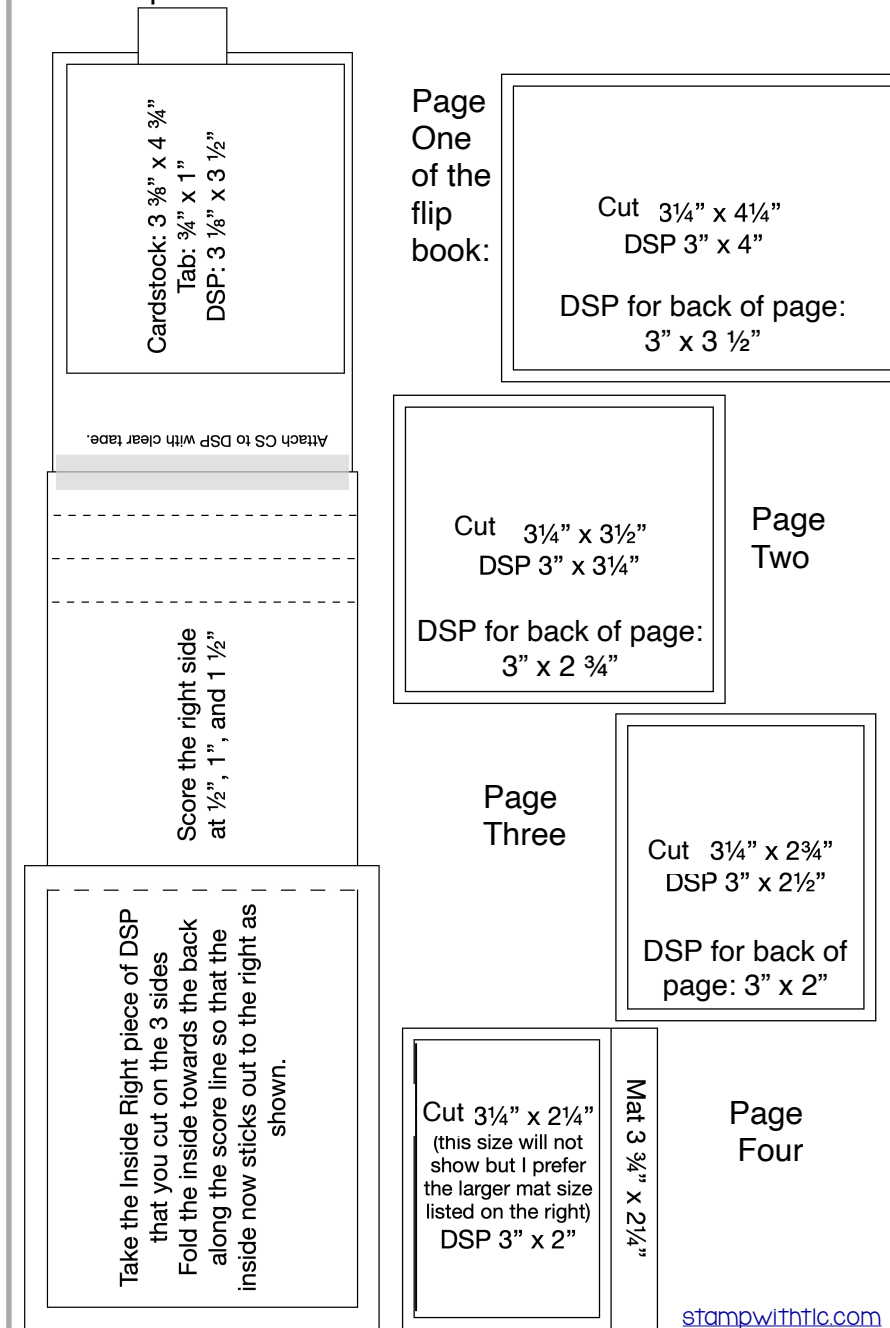
I used two different DSP's for the inside covers but you can use the same.

Inside Cover Pieces
 (Right Side)
 Cardstock 4 1/8" x 5 3/8"
 (cut center out leaving 1/2" margin all the way around)
 DSP 4" x 5 1/4"
 (cut center rectangle like the cardstock except leave right side uncut...score it instead.)

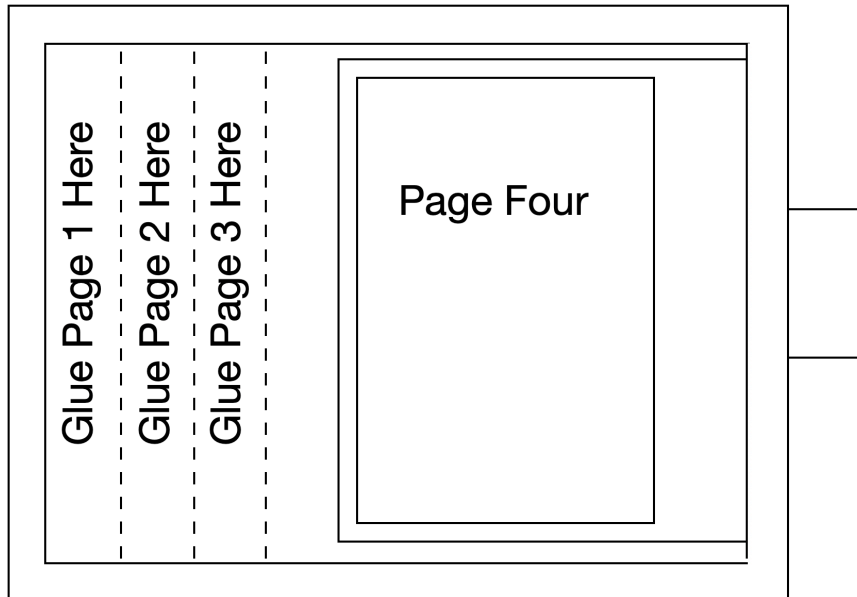
Put glue on the outer sides of DSP and attach to CS frame and then continue with next step.

Flip Book 2

Next Step: Assemble mechanism as shown on the left side.



Flip Book 3



Watching the video on my blog will help explain this part but I will try to write it out.

Fold the DSP with the attached cardstock section back to the inside of the frame and fold the taped cardstock section behind the DSP section. (Be sure to prefold the scored sections in the middle of the DSP for easy movement of the flipping mechanism.)

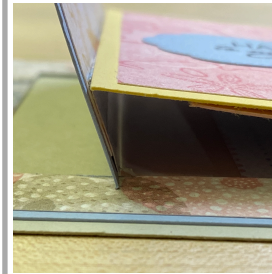
Adhere the top, left, and bottom sides of the Cardstock mat to the Card base being careful not to glue your mechanism to anything. You want to be able to pull the tab and have the scored sections flip under as you pull... this is what flips your pages that you will adhere.

Glue each page to each 1/2" section indicated above. The final page can be glued in the center and on the right side to help secure the flipping mechanism. Be sure not to glue the top and bottom edges though.

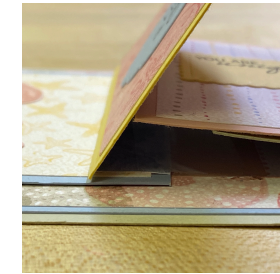
Flip Book 4
