
# Stampin' Spot Storage Box - 1

#### Materials:

- Paper Pumpkin Box and 2 cardboard inserts
- 1 Sheet 12" x 12" DSP to decorate outside of box
- 2 Sheets of Coordinating Cardstock for outside of box
- 3 Sheets of Carstock for each storage tray


### Paper Trays for inside of box:



Cut a slight angle on each tab on the corners before folding up the sides of the box. Adhere the cardboard insert from your paper pumpkin box to the inside bottom of your paper tray that you just made.



### **Paper Tray Dividers**



Fold along score lines forming a mountain peak on lines with a \*

Adhere the inside of the mountain folds so that it forms a single divider

You should have a total of 4 dividers

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## Stampin' Spot Storage Box - 2

piece A

4" x 4" scored on all sides ½"

piece C

Like the large paper tray, cut an angle on each tab before assembling this box. This box is the center of the tray.

Adhere pieces A, B, & C to the tray to the tray as shown in the picture below on top of the card board that you have already adhered.

Adhere this side to piece B & C


Adhere to the side of the tray.

Glue mountain fold together to make a divider

piece B

I did trim the front tab of the box.





Cut 1" X 1" squares to lable the bottom of each Stampin' Spot and another one to gllue to the bottom of the tray so that you can keep your spots organized.

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
