
Braided DSP 1

Choose 2 DSP papers with small designs that coordinate well with one another on the front as well as the back. I have used Heart Warming Hugs DSP for my card.

Step 1




For step 1: Cut two ½" x 12' stips from each piece of DSP

Glue piece A & B to piece C as shown in step 2

Step 3

Glue piece D to A & B as shown in step 3

In step 4, fold piece C at an angle so it aligns with A & B


In step 5 fold piece A over pieces B & C

> Keep braiding from the right side then left side until you have used up the strips





Step 8: Cut a coordinating piece (I used real red) of cardstock 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " and glue the braid to it as shown



Step 8

Step 9: Trim off the excess braid and use glue to tac down the bottom pieces of the braid

I used a Basic White card base to glue my braided strip with attached CS mat.

My sentiment came from the Holly Jolly Wishes stamp set and the ornaments are from Stars are Shining Bright Stamp Set.
