

Ways to use a 4" x 5 ¼" Piece of DSP

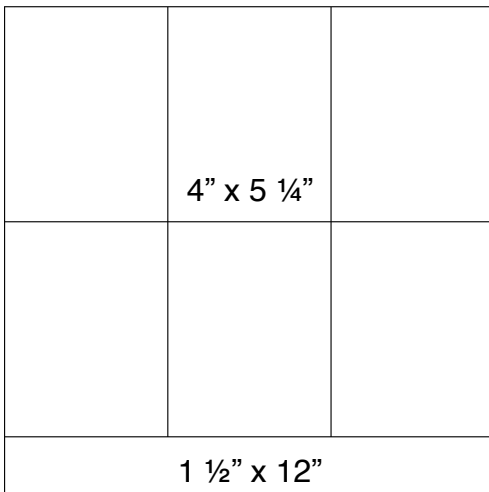
All the following cards are made with:

- 1 – 4 ¼" x 5 ½" Basic White card base
- 1 – 4" X 5 ¼" piece of Designer Series Paper
- 1 – Basic White Story label punch piece
- 2 – Medium Daisies punched from Basic White
- 1 – circle punched from So Saffron and embossed with the Tastefull Texture 3D embossing folder.

NOTE: The first card example is made with retired DSP and the 2nd example is made with new DSP from the 2022 Jan-June Mini catalog.

Different DSP and different punches can completely change the card for any occasion.

You can get 6 - 4" x 5 ¼" pieces from a 12" x 12" piece of DSP. You will have a strip leftover measuring 1 ½" x 12". This piece can be used to make a multitude of other cards so don't throw it away.



Card A: 3 Piece Portrait Card



Cut the 4" x 5 ¼" DSP into strips that measure 1 ¼" x 5 ¼". You will have a little leftover DSP when done.

- Sailboat Builder Punch
- New Horizons DSP
- Fresh Freesia cardstock
- Basic White cardstock
- Ink: Misty Moonlight and Cinnamon Cider
