Ways to use a 4" x 5 ¼" Piece of DSP

All the following cards are made with:


- $1 4 \frac{1}{4}$ " x 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Basic White card base
- $1-4'' \ge 5 \frac{1}{4}''$ piece of Designer Series Paper
- 1 Basic White Story label punch piece
- 2 Medium Daisies punched from Basic White

1 – circle punched from So Saffron and embossed with the Tastefull Texture 3D embossing folder.

NOTE: The first card example is made with retired DSP and the 2nd example is made with new DSP from the 2022 Jan-June Mini catalog.

Different DSP and different punches can completely change the card for any occasion.

You can get 6 - 4" x 5 $\frac{1}{4}$ " pieces from a 12" x 12"



Card A: 3 Piece Portrait Card



Cut the 4" x 5 $\frac{1}{4}$ " DSP into strips that measure 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 5 $\frac{1}{4}$ ". You will have a little leftover DSP when done.
