Bag-A-Lope

Step 1: Glue back flap closed


Step 2: Cut ¼" off one short edge of envelope

Step 3: Score other 3

sides at ¾"
Step 4: Fold

Step 4: Fold along score lines and burnish with bone folder (Fold the opposite way and burnish again)

Step 5: Glue 2 ½" X 4" piece of DSP between score lines. Leave room near the cut edge to punch holes for attaching ribbon.



Step 6: Open Envelope from the cut side and form the bag by pinching the bottom corners into a point and folding back towards the bottom of the bag. (This process is shown in the video and is easier to see than to read about.)



This shows the bottom of the bag. The left triangle has already been folded towards the bottom of the bag and the right triangle is ready to be folded towards the bottom of the bag and glued into place.

NOTE: Try this technique with different size envelopes and change the placement of the score lines for different bag widths.
