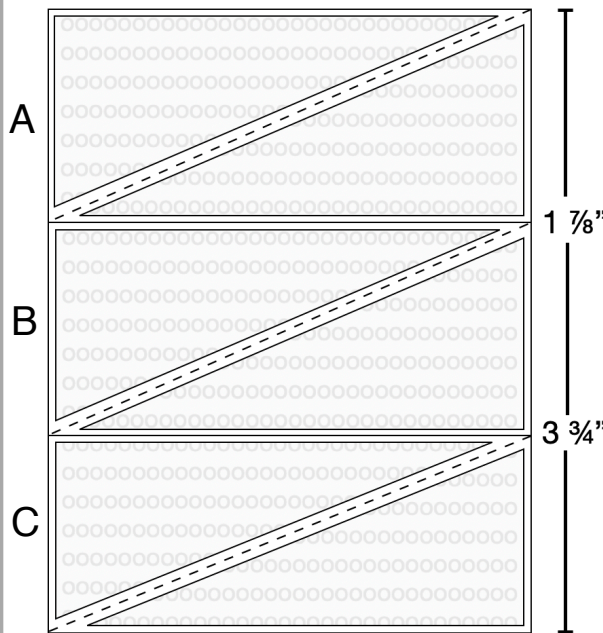


Tri Easel Card

A2 cardbase: 5 1/2" x 8 1/2"
score the long side at 4 1/4"



Start with a regular A2 card base.

Cut the front of the card base from the right side to the score line at 1 7/8" and 3 3/4".

Make a diagonal score line on each of the three flaps from the top right hand corner to bottom left corner. Fold along score line.

Sections A & B should measure 1 7/8" x 4 1/4"

Section C is 1 3/4" x 4 1/4"

Cut 2 pieces of DSP 1 5/8" x 4" and then cut on the diagonal. These pieces will be glued on Sections A & B.

Cut 1 piece of DSP 1 1/2" x 4" and then cut on the diagonal. These pieces will be glued to section C.

Now decorate with diecuts or punches.

Use a dimensional on the inside for each easel to prop up on. See the picture of the Cactus Cuties card.

I used three different dry embossing folders to add texture to the pots.
