
Triangle Scrap DSP Card



A2 Card Base: 5 1/2" x 8 1/2" scored on long side at 4 1/4"

Mat: 4" x 5 1/4" (I used an embossing folder on this piece.)

Mat for DSP: 3 1/4" x 4 1/4"

Designer Series Paper (DSP): 3 -5 Sheets cut to 3" x 4" rectangles

Note: 5 Sheets is too many for most trimmers as you can see in my video, but 3 should cut fine.

Stack your 3" x 4" DSP on top of one another and carefully cut the stack into triangles. Then mix and match the pieces to make multiple cards. Since I was using a stack of 5 pieces of DSP, I was able to make 5 cards.

Glue the DSP triangles onto the 3 1/4" x 4 1/4" and mount using Stampin' Dimensionals
