
DSP Framed Card 1



Start with a piece of DSP cut 3 ¾" x 5"

Using the Stitched Rectangle Dies, cut the DSP using the wide rectangles number 4 & 7 to cut a frame. (Start counting from one with the inside rectangle to find the 4th & 7th)

Use washi tape to hold the dies at the correct spacing to cut out the frame.

I flipped the inside piece of DSP to the other side which is why it looks like I cut a completely different piece of DSP.

I glued the inside piece directly to the white mat that I embossed with a 3d embossing folder that I now realised was discontinued. Oops.

I used dimensionals on the outside frame and on the flower that I die cut from the Awash in Beauty DSP using the Organic Beauty Dies.

I stamped my sentiment from True Beauty Stamp set, but the sentiment diecut came from the Eden die set,

Portrait A2 Card Base: 5 ½" x 8 ½" scored on the long side at 4 ¼"

I did add a little sparkle on the flower and sentiment with a Wink of Stella pen.
