

The Petal Park Punch was used for the flowers and they were embossed using Timeworn Type

## Card Base (Fresh <br> Freesia) $81 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 11^{\prime \prime}$

 scored on the long side at $51 / 2$ " and short side at $41 / 4$ " Then use a metal ruler, craft knife, and cutting mat to cut the cardstock in half along the diagonal. (Makes two card bases)

Basic White $37 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 5^{\prime \prime}$ cut on the diagonal DSP
$35 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 4$ 3/4" (Cut 2) cut on the diagonal and this will be enough for two cards (Unfortunately you can't flip the triangle) Make sure both pieces of DSP is facing the correct direction before cutting.
The hexagon die is from the Sentimental Park dies.
