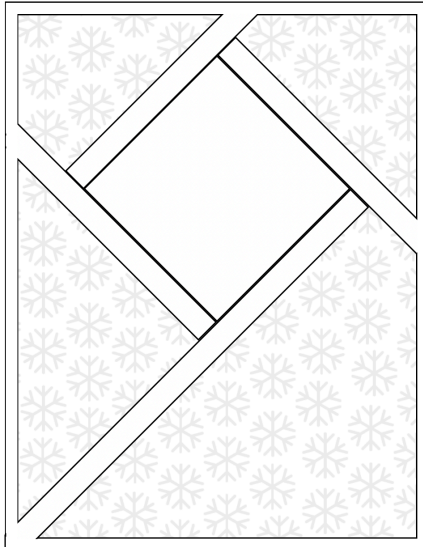
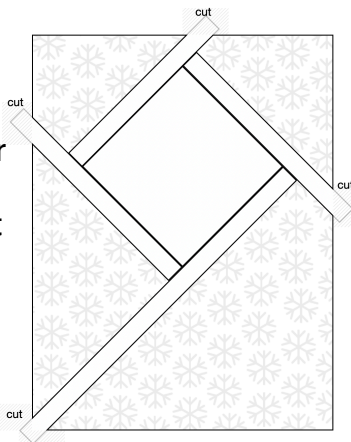


## Faux Fractured Card 1



1. Stamp on Basic White Die Cut square
2. Glue Square on point to the DSP
3. Starting at the edge of one corner of the white square, glue a 1/4" strip of cardstock along its side (it will overhang the DSP so you will need to trim it off.
4. Continue gluing 1/4" cardstock strips around the white square.
5. Flip over the DSP and trim off all the excess cardstock strips.
6. Now glue the DSP to the card base. If you use the same color cardbase as the 1/4" strips when you glue the DSP to the cardbase, the strips blend in to make it look like a more complicated card than it really is.



DSP before the cardstock strips are trimmed off.

**Note** Stylish Shapes dies: I used the middle square.
