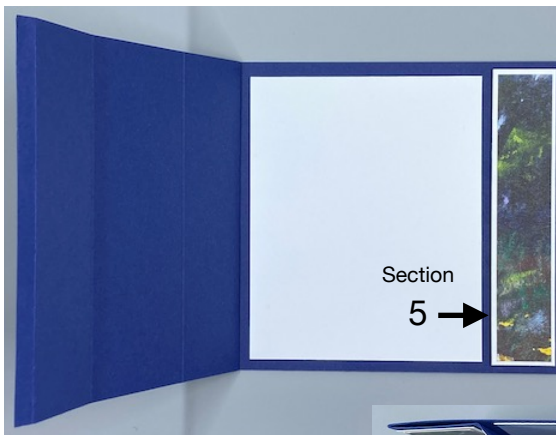
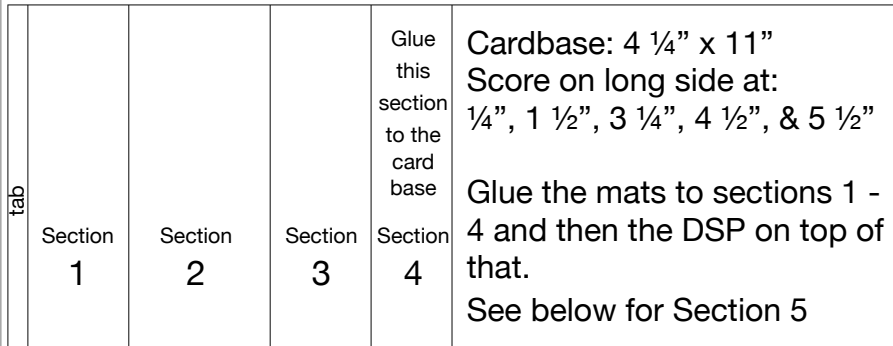


Basic White Mats:

- $\frac{7}{8}$ " x $4 \frac{1}{8}$ " (2)
- $1 \frac{1}{8}$ " x $4 \frac{1}{8}$ " (2)
- $1 \frac{5}{8}$ " x $4 \frac{1}{8}$ " (1)

DSP (see diagram)

- $\frac{3}{4}$ " X 4" (2)
- 1" X 4" (2)
- $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " X 4" (1)



Inside:
 Basic White:
 $3 \frac{1}{4}$ " X 4"

 Fifth section of the Bay window is mounted using Stampin' dimensionals on the inside of the card.

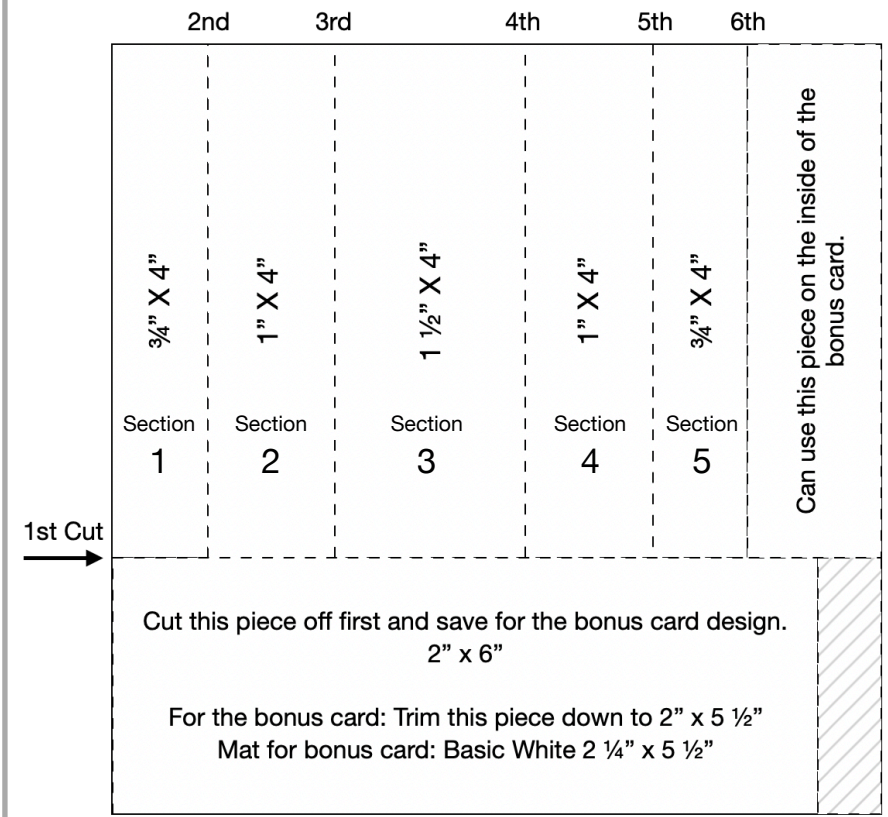
Bay Window Card 2

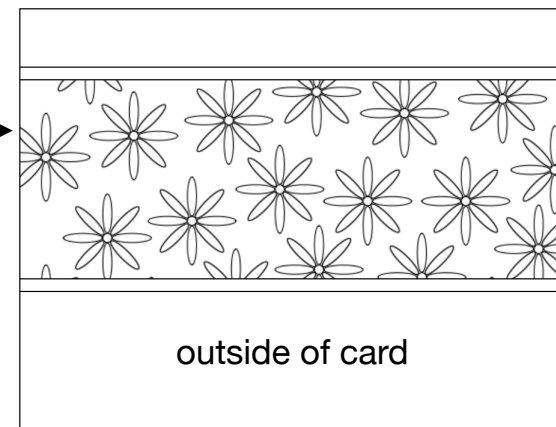

Card Base

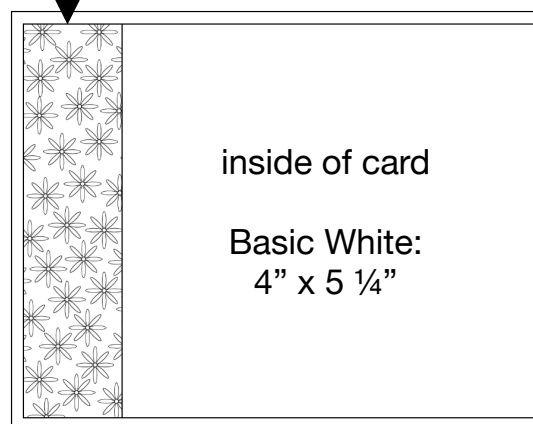
