
Jug with Flowers Card 1



Basic White Card base: $5 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $8 \frac{1}{2}$ " scored on long side at $4 \frac{1}{4}$ "

Early Espresso Mat: 4 1/8" x 5 3/8"

DSP: 4" x 5 ¼" piece cut in half to make two pieces measuring: 2" x 5 ¼"

1/8" x 5 1/4" piece of textured metallic paper

Multiple dies cut from 3 different sets as noted on page 2.

Step 1: Cut out all the pieces listed above

Step 2: Glue the two piece of DSP side by side on the Early Espresso Mat so that there is a slight margin all the way around but none in between the two pieces.

NOTE: My DSP was cut from the same piece of paper, but I flipped one of the pieces to the opposite side.

Step 3: Glue ¹/₈" strip of Textured metallic paper on top of the seam line between the two pieces of DSP

Step 4: Stamp a sentiment on the Scalloped Oval Piece


Step 5: Use Stampin Dimensionals to attach the Oval Piece to the card base.

Step 6: Glue the flower dies in place as shown on page 2

Step 7: Use Stampin' Dimensionals to adhere the metallic jug over the stem of the flowers

Step 8: Use 1 or 2 pieces of 6 inch twine and tie a bow. Use a dot of glue or glue dot to adhere the bow to the top of the jug.
