

Layers of Autumn Toile Card 1



Cutting Instructions & Materials Used:

- Early Espresso Card Base: 5 1/2" x 8 1/2" scored on the long side at 4 1/4"
- Cajun Craze Mat: 3 3/4" x 5 1/2"
- Cut a 3 3/4" x 5" piece of DSP and diecut simultaneously with the largest, middle and smallest die cut from the Branching Out die set* see tip
- Cut a 3 1/4" x 4 3/4" piece of Early Espresso Cardstock and die cut simultaneously with the 2nd and 4th largest die from the same set
- Sentiment piece is Basic Beige die cut using Traditional Labels dies
- Stem and Pine cone are cut from Earthen Toned Metallic cardstock using Branching Out die cuts
- Basic Beige Inside Piece: 4" x 5 1/4"


* **Tip:** When using multiple die cuts simultaneously, use tear and tape to attach all the die cuts together onto a scrap piece of thin copy paper. See Fig 1

Layers of Autumn Toile Card 2

Assembly Instructions:

- Fold Early Espresso card base
- Stamp the Basic Beige inside piece and glue to the inside of the card base. Sample uses Amber Autumn stamp set with Early Espresso Ink
- Glue stamped insert to the inside of the card
- Glue Cajun Craze mat to the front of the card.
- Start by gluing the largest DSP die cut piece to the center of the Cajun Craze piece and layer with the next size of Early Espresso. Continue to layer these pieces until you end with the smallest DSP die cut piece.
- Stamp the sentiment piece, Sample uses Amber Autumn stamp set with Early Espresso Ink
- Glue the Earthen Toned Berry Stem die cut to the back of the sentiment piece and the Earthen Toned Pine cone to the front.
- Attach the sentiment piece to the card front using Stampin' Dimensionals or glue.
