

## Split Front Fox Card 1



### Cutting Instructions & Materials Used:


- Cajun Craze Card Base: 4 1/4" x 7" scored on the long side at 5 1/2"
- Bottom Piece of Card Front: 1 1/2" x 4 1/4"
- Embossed Basic Beige Pieces: 1 3/8" x 4 1/8"
- (1) DSP & (2) Early Espresso Mat Die Cuts: Branching Out Dies
- Inside: DSP 2" x 5 1/4" and Basic Beige 4"x5 1/4"

- Die cuts using Earthen Toned Metallic
- Sentiment Die Cut: Words for the Season Dies
- Leaf Die Cut: Amber Autumn Dies

### Assembly Instructions:

- Fold Card base along the score line. The 1 1/2" flap is the card front.
- Glue the embossed Basic Beige Card stock to the top flap of the card front and the Bottom Piece of the Card Front
- Glue Die cut of the fox DSP to the Early Espresso Mat Die cut
- Align the bottom piece of the card front to the bottom of the card base and glue the Early Espresso die cut to both the top and the bottom sections of the card base connecting them together.

## Split Front Fox Card 2



This is the 2nd Early Espresso Die cut piece. The first is glued to the front and this one is added for extra stability.

### Assembly Instructions continued:

- Glue the 2nd Early Espresso Die cut on the back side of the piece you just glued to add extra stability to the card front.
- Lay the 2" wide DSP on the left side of the Basic Beige piece and stamp sentiment and images in Early Espresso
- Now glue the DSP in place and glue the Basic Beige Piece inside the card
- Glue Foil Die cut greetings and leaf to the front of the card
- Optional: Add Cajun Craze and Gold Dots to the front
