

## Autumn Toile Step Card 1



There is a separate file below where you downloaded this instruction sheet called the Step Card Template which gives instructions for creating the card base.

Once you have made your card base, refer to the picture to the right and below to help you fold along the score lines.




Instead of written instructions, the next page gives visual clues on how to cut decorations for the card base and where to glue the pieces.



## Autumn Toile Step Card 2

Stamp before glueing to the card base  
Basic Beige →  
1 3/8" x 4 1/8"



Autumn Tree Dies  
trunk: Early Espresso  
2 sets of leaves:  
Mossy Meadow and Pecan Pie

Early Espresso →  
1 3/8" x 4 1/8"

Pecan Pie  
2 1/2" x 3 1/2"  
then die cut

DSP →  
1 1/4" x 4"

Mossy Meadow  
2" x 3 1/2"  
then die cut

Sentiment Piece: Stamp your crumb cake piece before glueing to the mat.

Early Espresso Mat: 1" x 3 3/8"

Crumb Cake: 7/8" x 3 1/4"

**NOTE:** Cut the trunk before glueing if you want your card to fit in an A2 envelope. When the card is flat as in the picture above, the tree shouldn't go past the crumbcake cardstock if you want it to fit. The sample will not fit.

**2nd Note:** Glue only goes on the bottom half of the deer, grass, and tree trunk. Do not glue anything over your mountain folds.

**Pinecone Dies:**  
Branching Out dies and cut out of Earthen Toned Metallic
