

## Kintsugi Bandstand Card 1



### Cutting Instructions:

- Misty Moonlight Card base: 4 ¼" x 5 ⅜" scored on the long side at ¾" on both ends
- Misty Moonlight Card base Strips: 2 ½" x 7" scored on the long side at ¾", 2 ½", 4 ½", & 6 ¼" then cut down the center of the short side at 1 ¼" to make two strips.
- DSP for inside of card base (background) 4" x 5" and then with the 5" side at the top of your trimmer, cut off ⅝" from either side so that the design continues across the card.
- DSP for top and bottom strip: start with two strips that measure 1 ⅛" x 5 ¼" then cut the 5 ¼" length into three pieces that measure: 1 ⅝", 1 ⅞", & 1 ⅝" (cut in order to preserve design)
- DSP for sides on back of card base ⅝" x 4"
- Basic White for center back of card base: 3 ¾" x 4"

## Kintsugi Bandstand Card 2



### Assembly Instructions:

- Glue the DSP to the front of the card base.
- Glue the Misty Moonlight Strips to the top and bottom of the card base by folding over the ⅝" section on either side and gluing to the back of the card base.
- Cover these tabs that you glued with the DSP ⅝" x 4" strips for the back of the card base.
- Stamp the Basic White piece or add decoration and then glue to the center back of the card base
- Turn card to front and glue the 1 ⅝" & 1 ⅞" DSP pieces to each of the strips. The 1 ⅞" x 1 ⅛" piece goes in the center while each of the sides uses the 1 ⅝" x 1 ⅛" pieces
- Stamp the die cut sentiment piece and add to card with Stampin' Dimensionals
- Glue or attach vases with Stampin' Dimensionals only at the top and or bottom of the vase. The sample attaches the tall vase at the top and bottom with Stampin' Dimensionals while the bowl is only attached with Stampin' Dimensionals at the bottom.
