

Lights of Wonder Diorama Card 1



Cutting Instructions:

- Secret Sea Card Base: 5 ½" x 9 ¾" scored on the long side at: ⅝", 4 ⅜", 5", & 8 ¾"
- Middle Card Base Piece: 4 ½" x 5 ½" scored with the 4 ½" side at the top of the trimmer at ⅜" on each side.
- Use layering die cuts to cut the center hole from each of the card base pieces. The larger hole should be cut from the larger card base piece. (Sample uses Branching Out dies)


- Lights of Aurora DSP: 3" x 3"
- Cloud Cover: 1 ⅛" x 3 ½"
- Each of the following pieces are die cut with an edgelit die. The measurement is the starting measurement before die cutting.
- Mossy Meadow: 2 ½" x 3 ½"
- Gray Granite: 2" x 3 ½"
- Basic Gray: 3 ½" x 3 ½"
- Single tree diecut from Mossy Meadow that has been inked with a blending brush with Mossy Meadow ink.
- Sentiment piece from Textured Notes dies.
- Edgelits are from Scenic Adventures and Lights & Wonder die cut sets.

Lights of Wonder Diorama Card 2

Assembly Instructions:

- Glue 3" square of DSP to the inside of the larger card base piece. Do not glue it at the very top. Just go as high as needed so that you don't see the top edge when card it on display.
- Each of the edgelit pieces should be flush with the bottom of each of the pieces it is glued to. **NOTE:** only put glue where the piece is touching the card base.
- Glue the Basic Gray mountain to the back side of the smaller card base piece so that it shows through the window and the bottoms are even.
- Glue the Gray Granite hill to the front of the smaller card base piece with the bottoms even.
- Glue the Mossy Meadow trees to the back of the larger window card base piece and then glue the Cloud Cover piece behind it.
- See the pictures on the next page to see how to glue in the middle section and close the card base.
- After stamping the sentiment piece, it can be glued to the front of the card base.
- Now glue the tree to the sentiment piece.
- Optional: Glue a 3 ½" x 5 ¼" piece of Basic White to the back to write a message. **NOTE:** Stamp it first before glueing in place.

Lights of Wonder Diorama Card 3




- Place the smaller card base piece tab next to the score line on the larger card base piece as shown above.
- Put glue on the tab of the smaller piece and fold over the front of the card to glue in place.
- The smaller card base tab is smaller than the section on the larger card base because you want the window to be in the middle of the card when open.

Lights of Wonder Diorama Card 4



- Once the left side is glued, follow the same procedure on the right side.
- The edge of the smaller card base tab should be right next to the score line of the larger card base tab.
- Place glue on the tab for the smaller card base section and fold over the tab from the larger card base piece on top of the smaller card base tab.
- With inside folded down flat, glue the final larger card base tab on top of the two tabs you just glued together.

Lights of Wonder Silhouette Card 1



Cutting Instructions:

Blackberry Bliss Card Base: 5½" x 8½" scored on the long side at 4 ¼"

Basic White Mat: 4 ⅛" x 5 ⅜"

Basic Black cut at 4" x 5 ¼" and then die cut using the tree edgelit from the Light & Wonder die set

DSP: 3" x 5 ¼"

Optional Blackberry Bliss scrap cut at: 1" x 3"

Inside Basic White Piece: 4" x 5 ¼"

Glimmer Paper: ⅞" x 2 ⅜"

Basic White Sentiment Piece die cut from Textured Notes measures approximately: ¾" x 2 ¼"

Lights of Wonder Silhouette Card 2

Assembly Instructions:

- Fold Card base in half and glue Basic White mat to the outside.
- Glue Designer Series Paper to the top section of the Basic White Piece leaving an ⅛" margin on the top and both sides.
- **Optional:** Glue the 1" x 3" piece of blackberry bliss just below the DSP on the bottom right side. This keeps the white from peeing through the trunks. **Note:** You can just cut your DSP long enough to hide this section, but I wanted to get two cards out of one 6x6 piece of DSP so this was my fix.
- Use Stampin' Dimensionals to attach the silhouette of trees so that there is a ⅛" margin of white on the bottom and both sides.
- Stamp the sentiment piece and glue to the glimmer paper. **NOTE:** use glue dots or let the tombow adhesive dry before sticking the basic white to the glimmer paper.
- Glue the Glimmer paper to the front of the trees.
- Stamp a sentiment on your 4" x 5 ¼" Basic White piece and glue to the inside of your card.
