Cherry Cobbler Card Base:
4 1/4" x 11" scored on long
side at: 3 3/4" x 9 1/4"

Basic White Mats:
top section: 3 5/8" x 4 1/8"
bottom section: 1 5/8" x 4 1/8"

DSP
top section: 3 1/2" x 4"
bottom section: 1 1/2" x 4"

Basic White Sentiment
piece cut using Traditional

Shaded Spruce Sliding
Pocket: 3 1/2" x 7" scored on

Elegant Pine Gift Card Holder Card 2

Assembly Instructions:

- Fold Card Base so that the top and bottom flap meet and do not overlap. Burnish the score lines after folding.
- Glue Basic White mats to top and bottom sections of the front of the card base
- Glue DSP to top and bottom sections of the card front
- Stamp Basic White Sentiment piece and attach with Stampin' Dimensionals to the top section of the card front.
- Decorate the sentiment piece with Delicate Pine Die cuts using Shaded Spruce and Old Olive
- Optional: Add Decorative Snowflake embellishments
- Glue the sides of the bottom flap to the inside of the card base forming a pocket.
- Fold the score lines on the Shaded Spruce pocket piece so that the 1/2" section folds behind the middle section and the larger section folds on top of the middle section forming the pocket. Burnish the score lines.
- Now unfold so that the top of the 1/2" section is lined up right along the top score line of the inside of the Cherry Cobbler Card Base. Do not overlap the score line.
- Place glue or tear N tape on the 1/2" tab along the top of the Shaded Spruce piece and fold the top of the card base on top of it. The 1/2" section should now be glued to the card base in such a way that when you open the top of the card it pulls up on the Shaded Spruce piece.
- Glue the DSP as shown
- Glue the sides of the bottom flap and fold towards the DSP to form the pocket. Only glue the sides.
- Stamp the Basic White piece and glue to the pocket.
- Tuck the Shaded Spruce Pocket inside the Cherry Cobbler Pocket.
- If all went well the pocket will move up and down when the card is opened and closed.
