


# Naure Walk Z-Fold Card



**T**his Z-Fold card features the Nature Walk Designer Series Paper and the Gliding Garden Swing Dies.

## Project Recipe:



### 1. Lost Lagoon Card Base:


4 1/4" x 11" scored on the long side at 2 3/4" and 5 1/2"

Lost Lagoon Skinny Strip:

1 1/4" x 11" scored on the long side at 2 3/4" and 5 1/2"

Fold the card base so that the Z-fold opens to the left.

The Skinny Strip's long section is on the left and the two smaller sections fold underneath the long section. Basically the opposite of the card base.



### 2. Layers for Card Base:

Section A:

Basic White: 2 5/8" x 4 1/8"

DSP: 2 1/2" x 4"

Section B:

Basic White: 2 5/8" x 4 1/8"

Embossed Pretty Peacock: 2 1/2" x 4"

(Exposed Brick 3D Embossing Folder)

Section C:

Basic White: 5 3/8" x 4 1/8"

DSP: 2 3/4" x 4"

Glue the Basic White Pieces to the coordinating section of the card base first and then add the extra layer of DSP or Dry Embossed card stock.



### 3. Pretty Peacock Cardstock for Skinny Strip:

After cutting dry emboss all three pieces using the Exposed Brick 3D embossing folder.

Section D: 1 1/8" x 5 3/8"

Sections E & F: 1 1/8" x 2 5/8"

Glue each embossed piece of Pretty Peacock to the Lost Lagoon skinny strip



### 4. Die Cuts from Gliding Garden Swing die set

Leaves and Pillow are diecut from DSP

Tree trunk is die cut from a 4" x 5 1/4" piece of Early Espresso (The die is larger than the cardstock, but this is okay because the full die cut tree would not fit in the envelope.)

Background of the swing is die cut from Pecan Pie

Swing details are die cut from Crumb Cake

Assemble pieces as shown.

The swing is glued to the skinny piece for support.

The ropes of the swing are glued to the back of the leaves.

Sentiment piece is punched with the Three Banner Punch using Crumb Cake.

Sentiment stamp is from the Gliding Swing Stamp Set and the ink is Early Espresso.
