


Joyful Squares Card



This card features the Square Snippets DSP and Joyful Squares dies. This is a two for one card, in that two coordinating squares of Joyful Snippets DSP are die cut using the square frame die from Joyful Squares. These die cut pieces are then divided to make two different card layouts.

Supplies needed:

- Joyful Squares Bundle (English) [166850] [166850]
- Square Snippets 12" X 12" (30.5 X 30.5 Cm) Designer Series Paper [166993] [166993]
- Swirled Designs Dies [167032] [167032]
- All In A Row Embossing Folder [166989] [166989]
- 1-3/4" (4.4 Cm) Circle Punch [119850] [119850]
- Secret Sea 8 1/2" X 11" Cardstock [165624] [165624]
- Basic White 8 1/2" X 11" Cardstock [159276] [159276]
- Secret Sea Classic Stampin' Pad [165285] [165285]

Project Recipe:

	<p>1. Both card designs use the same number of pieces but the pieces are mixed up after two squares from the Square Snippets Designer Series Paper is die cut using the frame from Joyful Squares.</p> <p>Start by cutting apart the squares from one piece of Square Snippets Designer Series Paper. Choose two squares that coordinate together. My card uses a Secret Sea Square and a Blue Polka Dotted Square. Die cut both these squares with the frame die cut.</p>
	<p>2. Using all the pieces die cut from the square including the outside edge. Swap the middle piece from both squares so that each card has 3 squares total.</p>
	<p>3. Cut 2 regular card bases measuring 5 1/2" x 8 1/2" scored on the long side at 4 1/4" The Sample uses Secret Sea and Basic White</p> <p>Also cut a mat in each of the colors used to make your card bases and emboss using the All in a Row embossing folder (4" x 5 1/4")</p>
	<p>4. Punch a Basic White circle for each card using the 1 3/4" circle punch</p> <p>Die cut the flower from Swirled Designs die set in each of the card base colors.</p>



5. In this version of the card.

Secret Sea Card base and Basic White Mat

The Secret Sea squares are glued directly to the embossed Basic White Mat.

The Polka Dot Frame is attached using Stampin' Dimensionals.

All the squares are lined up perfectly.

Stamp the sentiment using Secret Sea ink and ink the edges of the circle before attaching it to the center of the squares using Stampin' Dimensionals.

Finally glue the Secret Sea Flower to the Polka Dot frame and the Sentiment circle.

Add a piece of Basic White measuring 4" x 5 1/4" to the inside of the card.



6. The landscape version of this card uses a Basic White Card base with a Secret Sea Mat.

The mat is glued to the card front like the last card, but this time the squares are placed at alternating angles and glued together only where the squares touch.

The squares are then attached to the card front using Stampin' Dimensionals.

Stamp the sentiment on the Basic White circle and ink the edges. Glue the sentiment to the squares as shown.

Glue the flower directly to the mat with the stem tucked underneath the outermost square.
