

Simple 3 Piece DSP Card



This card uses 3 pieces of DSP cut in rectangles. Large print DSP is a great choice for this card.

Supplies needed:

- Lovely & Beautiful 12" X 12" (30.5 X 30.5 Cm) Specialty Designer Series Paper [166957] [166957] \$16.50
- Beautifully Celebrated Dies [166974] [166974] \$35.00
- Beautiful Pattern 3 D Embossing Folder [167097] [167097] \$10.50
- Lovely Arrangements Photopolymer Stamp Set (English) [167169] [167169] \$20.00
- Pearlized Faceted Circles [166978] [166978] \$8.00
- Petal Pink 8-1/2" X 11" Cardstock [146985] [146985] \$14.00
- Basic White 8 1/2" X 11" Cardstock [166780] [166780] \$14.00
- Fresh Freesia 8 1/2" X 11" Cardstock [155613] [155613] \$14.00
- Gorgeous Grape Classic Stampin' Pad [147099] [147099] \$9.00
- Stampin' Dimensionals [104430] [104430] \$4.25

Project Recipe:

1. Petal Pink Card Base: 5 ½" x 8 ½"
scored on the long side at 4 ¼"

Fresh Freesia Mat: 3" x 5" and then dry embossed with Beautiful Pattern 3D embossing folder

Lovely & Beautiful Designer Series Paper: 4" x 3 ¼"

Then cut along the 4" side to make 3 pieces that measure:

1 ¼" x 3 ¼"

1 ½" x 3 ¼"

1 ¼" x 3 ¼"



2. Glue embossed cardstock to the center of the card base.

Glue the three pieces of DSP on top of the embossed cardstock as shown in the picture.

Die cut a Petal Pink piece of cardstock with Beautifully Celebrated Dies

Stamp a sentiment using Gorgeous Grape ink to the die cut piece and attach to card base using Stampin' Dimensionals.

Sample uses the Lovely Arrangements stamp set



3. Cut a piece of Basic White cardstock 4" x 5 ¼" for the inside. Stamp as desired and glue to the inside of the card.
