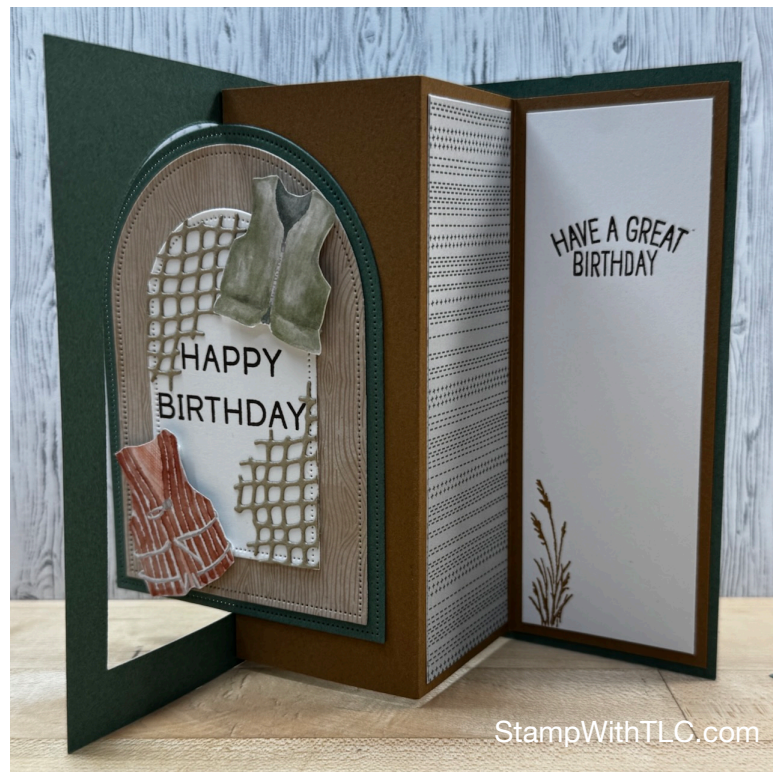


Waterside Retreat Inside Box Card

Independent Stampin' Up Demonstrator



Peaceful Pine Card Base: 5½" x 8½"
scored on the long side at 4 ¼"

DSP: 4" x 5 ¼"

Glue DSP to card front only on the edges so that when you Die cut the Everyday Arch from the front of the card, you can easily separate the DSP from the card stock.

Flip the DSP over and die cut it again using the next smaller sized arch and glue it to the card stock arch.

Pecan Pie Inside Piece: 5 ¼" x 8"
scored on the long side at 2", 4" & 6"

Inside DSP and Basic White Piece:
1 ¾" x 5"

Everyday Arches Dies: cut Basic White two sizes smaller than the DSP arch

DSP: Fussy cut two vests from the Waterside Retreat DSP

Sunset Coast Dies: Crumb Cake net

Assembly:

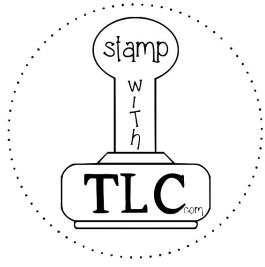
Fold the **Peaceful Pine** card base in half along the score line.

Fold the **Pecan Pie** card base along the score lines, creating two mountain folds on the first two score lines and one valley fold on the last score line.

Glue the striped DSP and the stamped Basic White cardstock onto either side of the valley fold. These will be the two right-most sections of the Pecan Pie piece.

Glue the section with the stamped Basic White piece to the inside of the Peaceful Pine card base.
NOTE: When adhering this piece, make sure there is an equal margin along the top, bottom, and right side.

Fold the green striped DSP section over the Basic White section, then lay the remaining half of the Pecan Pie piece flat.

Assembly continued:

Fold the **Peaceful Pine** card base in half along the score line.

Fold the **Pecan Pie** card base along the score lines, forming two mountain folds on the first two score lines and one valley fold on the last score line.

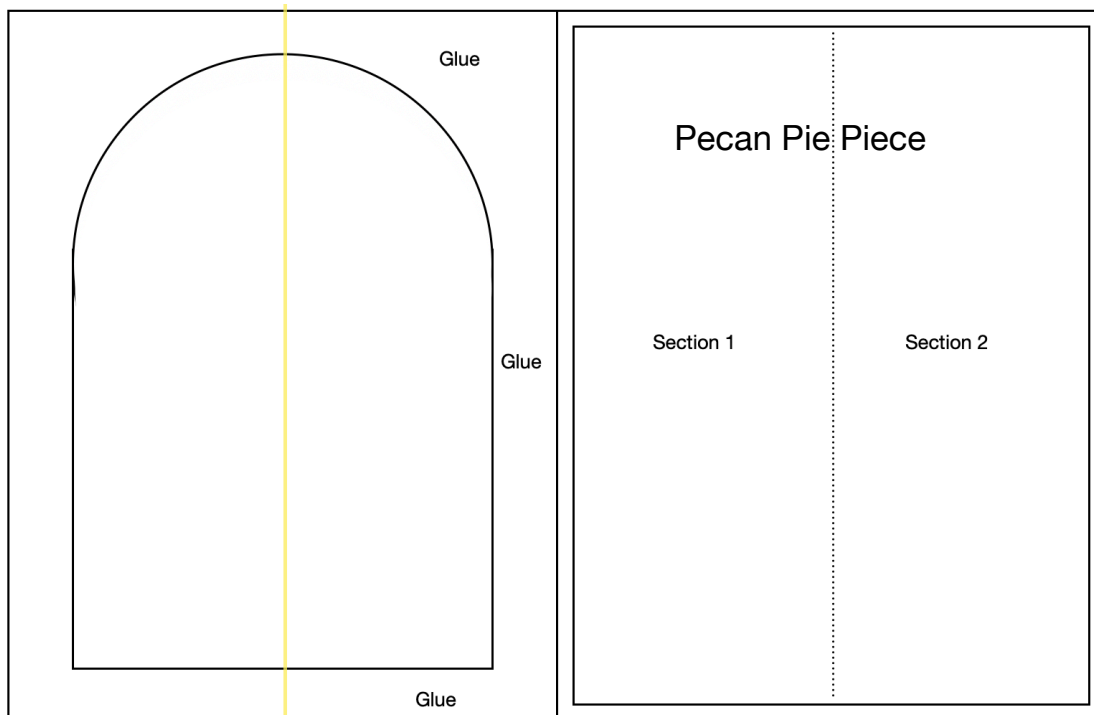
Glue the striped DSP and the stamped Basic White cardstock to either side of the valley fold. These will be the two right-most sections of the Pecan Pie piece.

Glue the section with the stamped Basic White piece to the inside of the Peaceful Pine card base. **NOTE:** When adhering this piece, make sure there is an equal margin along the top, bottom, and right side.

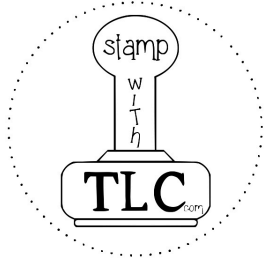
Fold the green striped DSP section over the Basic White section, then lay the remaining half of the Pecan Pie piece flat.

Apply glue to the inside of the card base as indicated in the sketch below. Be careful not to apply glue past the yellow line.

Fold the card base closed and allow the glue to set. This completes the box. When you open the card, it will pop up to form a box shape.

Assembly continued:

With the card base closed, you will see the score line on the Pecan Pie piece.

Glue the **Peaceful Pines Every Day** arched die-cut piece to the Pecan Pie panel, positioning it to the right of the score line as shown in the picture below. Be sure to apply adhesive only to the portion that will attach to the Pecan Pie panel.

When you open the card, the arch will flip out and stand perpendicular to the arched opening on the front of the card base, as shown in the photo at the beginning of the instructions.

Decorate the arch by layering on the smaller woodgrain arch.

Stamp your sentiment on the Basic White piece. Glue a portion of the net to one side of the Basic White piece and trim off the excess. Use the remaining net to decorate the other side of the arch.

Add the fussy-cut life vest to the arch using Stampin' Dimensionals™, making sure the Dimensionals do not extend beyond the edges of the arch.
