

Simple Waterside Pocket Card

Form the Pocket:

Starting with the right flap, apply glue only along the bottom edge of the fold and close it.

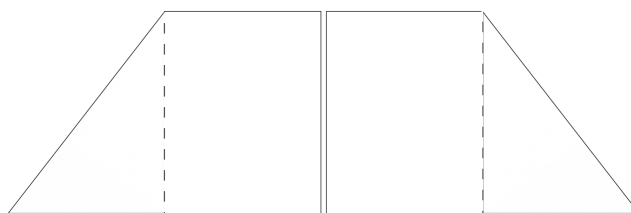
Next, place glue along the bottom edge of the left triangular piece and partially up the diagonal edge. Close this flap over the right-side triangle.

You should now have a pocket formed.

Decorate the pocket using circles from the **Spotlight on Nature Dies** and a Circle Punch. Add a Gray Granite chair die cut using the **Waterside Retreat Dies**. Attach all decorative elements using Stampin' Dimensionals™.

Misty Moonlight Card Base:

- Cut two pieces at 5½" x 8½".
- Score each piece on the long side at 4¼".
- Cut the front of each card base at an angle as shown in the picture below.



Trim the right card base by 1/16" so it will fit neatly inside the left card base.

Glue the back of the right card base to the inside of the left card base.

Waterside Retreat DSP:

- Cut to 3¾" x 5".
- Cut on the diagonal to create two triangles.
- Flip one triangle over to mirror the design.

The sample uses two different DSP patterns, and I created two different versions of the card.

Glue the DSP triangles to the front of each triangular flap.

Inside Piece:

- Gray Granite: 3¾" x 5"
- Basic White: Die cut using the **Perennial Postage Dies**

Glue Basic White die cut piece to Gray Granite piece and insert into pocket.s

Optional: Dew Drop Embellishments
