Cardstock & Designer Series Paper Measurements

Blackberry Bliss Card Base

- 4¼" x 11", scored on the 11" side at 2¾" and 5½"

Blackberry Bliss Strip

- 1½" x 11", scored on the 11" side at 2¾" and 5½"

Valley in Bloom Designer Series Paper

For the Card Base

- 2½" x 4" (cut 2)
- 4" x 5¼"

For the Strip

- 1¼" x 5¼"
- 1¼" x 2½" (cut 2)

Die Cuts

- **Garden Green:** Lily of the Valley leaf
- **Granny Apple Green:** Lily of the Valley leaf
- **Blackberry Bliss:** Sweet Words & Labels die (see sample photo for the shape used)
- **Basic Beige:** Sweet Words & Labels die, then dry emboss using the Floral Spray 3D Embossing Folder
- **Basic White:** Front sentiment die cut and inside sentiment die cut (two different dies from the Sweet Words & Labels Dies)

Stamp Set

- Sending Salutations Stamp Set

Dies

- Lily of the Valley Dies
- Sweet Words & Labels Dies

Ink

- Crushed Curry
- Blackberry Bliss
- Garden Green

Additional Supplies

- Wink of Stella Glitter Brush



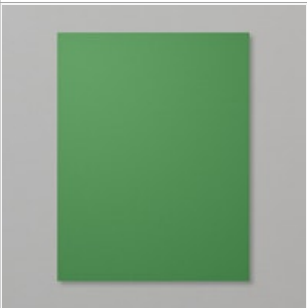
Card Assembly



Assembly Instructions

1. Glue the Basic Beige Designer Series Paper to the first two sections of the card base.
2. Glue the floral Designer Series Paper to the third (far-right) section of the card base.
3. Glue the Crushed Curry Designer Series Paper pieces to the Blackberry Bliss strip. The longest section of the strip should be on the left.
4. Stamp the front and inside sentiment pieces. Glue the larger sentiment piece to the middle section of the card base.
5. Attach the strip to the card base so the bottom edge of the strip is flush with the bottom of the card and the sides are aligned.
Note: Glue only the left end of the strip to the first section of the Z-fold. Glue the right end of the strip to the third section of the card base. Do not apply glue to the center section so the card can open and close properly.
6. Watercolor the embossed Basic Beige die cut, then layer it onto the Blackberry Bliss die cut.
7. Cut both leaf die cuts in half and arrange them as shown in the sample photo. Glue the leaves in place, then adhere the layered embossed die cut over them.
Note: Apply adhesive only where the die cut overlaps the first Z-fold section and the Crushed Curry strip. This allows the card to open correctly.
8. Attach the sentiment piece with Stampin' Dimensionals as shown in the sample photo.
