CUTTING & SCORING

CARD BASE

Hydrangea Hue or Old Olive Cardstock

- 5 ½" x 8 ½"
- Score at 4 ¼" on the long side

ARROW FOLDS

See **Diagram 1.0 on Page 2**.

1. Make a small pencil mark at the center of the bottom edge of the card front — 2 ¾".
2. From the fold on each side, score diagonally to the center mark.
3. Measure 2 ⅛" **down from the fold** on each side and make a pencil mark.
4. Score from each pencil mark diagonally to the bottom-center mark.

You should now have **four angled score lines** forming the Arrow.

DSP — LARGE TRIANGLES

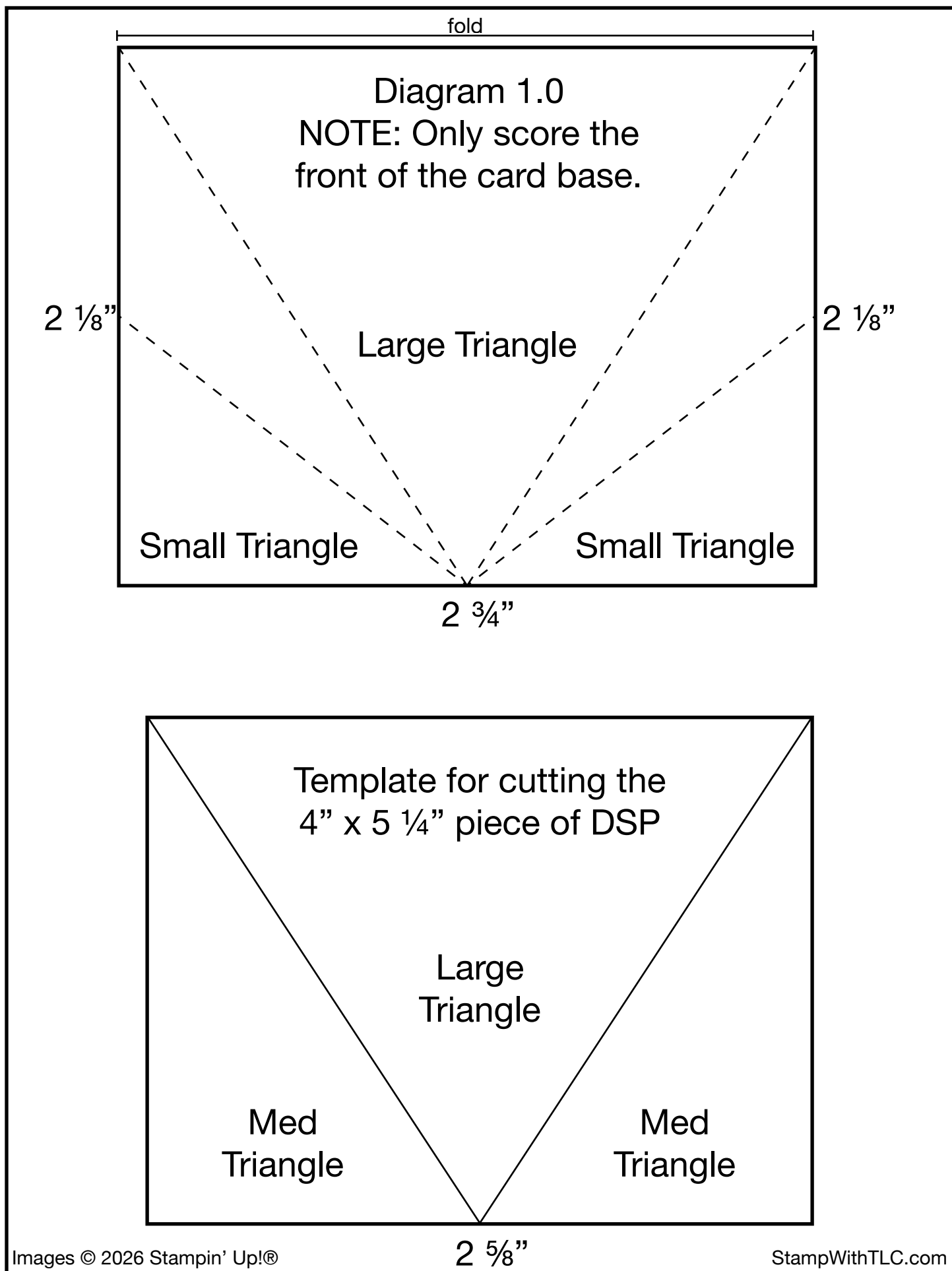
Use the **Large Triangle Template on Page 2**.

Start with:

- DSP — 4" x 5 ¼"

Place the template in the center of the DSP and cut the triangle.

Tip: Using the template this way automatically creates the pieces needed for the **two Medium Triangles**, so you can skip the Medium Triangle cutting instructions.



DSP — MEDIUM TRIANGLES

Skip this section if you used the medium triangles left over from using the Large Triangle Template.

You will need:

- **Two DSP pieces — 2 ¾" x 4"**
 1. Place the two pieces together with the **right sides facing each other**.
 2. Cut diagonally across both pieces.

This creates enough pieces for **two cards**.

Right sides together simply means the sides of the DSP you want showing on your finished card are facing each other while cutting.

DSP — SMALL TRIANGLES

Optional

You can leave these areas as cardstock if you prefer.

For the sample, DSP was used.

You will need:

- **Two DSP pieces — 1 ⅞" x 2 ½"**

Place the pieces together with the **right sides facing each other** and cut diagonally.

This creates enough pieces for **two cards**.

OTHER PIECES

Basic White

- 4" x 5 ¼" — inside of card
- 1 die-cut sentiment piece using **Sweet Words & Labels Dies**

Hydrangea Hue Cardstock

- 3 small blooms using **Flowering Meadows Dies**



ASSEMBLY

1. FORM THE ARROW

Fold the card base in half along the **4 ¼" score line**, then open.

Turn the card so you are looking at the **inside**.

On one side:

- Fold the **long angled score line** toward the inside of the card.
- Fold the **shorter angled score line** back toward the first fold.

Repeat on the other side.

2. SECURE THE LARGE FOLDS

Apply glue to the **larger folded sections** and attach them to the card base.

Do not glue the small triangles yet.

3. ADD THE SMALL DSP

Close the card and turn it so you are looking at the **front**.

If using DSP on the small triangles:

- Unfold the small triangles.
- Glue the DSP to the **front-facing side**.
- Fold the triangles back into position.
- Add glue to the portion that will be hidden underneath the larger triangle.
- Attach the small triangle to the larger triangle.

Repeat on the other side.

4. DECORATE THE INSIDE

Place the two **Medium Triangles** onto the Basic White 4" x 5 ¼" piece.

This will show you how much room remains for a stamped sentiment.

Stamp your sentiment before gluing the triangles down.

Glue the Medium Triangles to the Basic White piece, then attach the completed piece to the inside of the card.

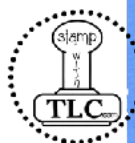
5. FINISH THE FRONT

Stamp the Basic White sentiment piece.

The sample uses **Old Olive Ink** and the **Poetic Petals** Stamp Set.

Decorate with the **three Hydrangea Hue** flowers.

Attach the sentiment piece to the card front using **Stampin' Dimensionals** or glue.
